

Dear Sir/Madam,

As per the directions of NPIU vide order No. NPIU/TEQIP-III/Acad./442 dt. 05 June, 2018, MNIT Jaipur made enabling provisions to admit TEQIP faculty sponsored by your institute to pursue PhD. In consultation with NPIU, it is pertinent to reiterate the following points.

1. Understanding that there is sufficient research infrastructure available at your institute, the sponsored faculty is deemed to carry out research at his/her parent institute. In case there is any shortcoming of research infrastructure, the parent institutes can develop relevant infrastructure at their institute, which would be of value to the institute in the long run. Expenses towards this may be charged to TEQIP III.
2. With a similar understanding, the residency requirement has been partly waived off, as per special arrangement facilitated by MNIT-J for TEQIP. The scholar contact program has been fixed at eighty days over an academic year, which could be pursued during holidays/vacation periods. These could be spread with at least 4 recorded visits to MNIT Jaipur in a year, using which the candidate can fulfil his/her supervisor interaction and all other official requirements. In this connection, the parent institutions are requested to grant them suitable duty leave to pursue their research at MNIT Jaipur. MNIT Jaipur would provide attendance record at regular intervals of all such faculty visiting MNIT Jaipur for research interaction.
3. As this research pursuance would involve registration fees and travel expenses, you could consider supporting these expenses, from the TEQIP faculty development at your institute.

Hope this helps a comfortable research environment for the faculty and their parent institutions.
