Sessional Marks Distribution

1. Abstract (**20 marks**): Brief introduction of the project with the responsibilities of the team members and justification. 2. Attendance (**10 marks**): Team member individual attendance is compulsory twice a week to the concern supervisor.
3. *Project Progress Projection: (**30 marks**)
 - Desired- Planning (problem statement), questionnaire, ER diagrams and DFD's.
4. Final stage (**30 marks**)
 - Implementation- Coding, testing and maintenance

*Note: Project Progress Projection Report (PPPR) has to submit after 2 months with the comment of both the supervisors on it. PPPR carries **10 marks**.

Report Writing (**20marks**)

Report should be hard bound with black colour, the text of the front page will be golden along with the CD.

End Semester Practical Marks Distribution

1. Viva **30 marks** – it will be open house presentation in which team member has to give the presentation and explain his responsibilities in

the making of the project. It carries 1/2 hr time for viva. It will be based on individual team member.

2. Presentation **20 marks**– this section will be based on the presentation skill of the speaker individually. This number is given by the recommendation of the concern supervisor and the observation based on the presentation of the speaker.
3. Attendance at the time of viva **10 marks**.
4. Live Demo **20 marks**- it will be based at which time team has given the demo. More marks will be considered if the satisfactorily demo will given at the time of presentation.
