### BOY'S HOSTEL RULES

#### **GENERAL:**

Govt. College of Engineering Jhalawar provides infrastructural facilities of Boarding & Lodging to a limited number of regular students who want to pursue their studies seriously. The hostel facilities are run on payment basis by college management.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

1. Only the regular students of GECJ are eligible for admission to the hostels.
2. If the number of seats available in the hostel is less than the applications received, the preference will be given to the first year students than other students on the basis of first come first get.
3. The re-admission cases shall be considered on the last priority.
4. The allotment made by the college management shall be final and binding.
5. A student, on whom disciplinary action / fine was imposed by hostel/college administration, shall be given accommodation in hostel after depositing fine on last priority.

#### **OTHER CONDITIONS:**

6. An eligible student will be allowed to stay in the hostel for a maximum period of 4 years (B.Tech), 3 years (BBA and BCA) and 2 years (MBA).
7. Non-payment of college, hostel and mess dues by the last stipulated dates will disqualify the student for further stay in the hostel. (Clearing hostel dues in time shall be the sole responsibility of the student. Defaulters would have to pay a fine of Rs 100/- per day) All necessary actions as deemed fit will be taken by the College administration to realize the dues which may include debarring the defaulters from examination, expulsion from the hostel and financial penalty.
8. All resident students will vacate the hostel every year within three days of the last date of their examination or as ordered by college administration. The student will have to vacate the hostel during summer vacations unless otherwise is permitted by the college administration.
9. The inmates of the hostel will be required to maintain the infrastructural facilities such as building, furnishing, fittings, etc. in good condition. In case of any damage or loss, the replacement will be at the cost of the occupants or user of the facilities. The occupants will be responsible for the cleanliness of their rooms. They will help in maintaining cleanliness in hostel facilities such as bathrooms, lavatories, mess, common room, corridors and surroundings by their proper use.
10. No occupant shall sublet any accommodation, failing which disciplinary action will be taken against the allottee and illegal occupant both. The allotment of the room will be cancelled immediately along with a fine of Rs. 2000/- with forfeiture of the mess caution money and mess advance.
11. No student is allowed to interchange his /her room with others, failing in such case cause which strict disciplinary action.
12. No student, under any circumstances shall be permitted to remain absent from the hostel between 9p.m to 6 a.m. permission to stay out during these hours, if required, shall be obtained in advance from the competent authority in writing.
13. Students shall have to maintain discipline at all time to create an atmosphere conducive to peaceful living and studies in the hostel. Disturbance in the campus will cause expulsion from the hostel.
14. No student is permitted to keep weapons and / or devices which may cause injury to others and the possession which is punishable under IPC. Students found in possession of such weapons /devices, shall invite appropriate disciplinary action (legal action may also be initiated) and cancellation of their hostel accommodation and / or imposition of a fine up to Rs.2000/-
15. No resident is allowed to keep his/her personal fan, furniture, air cooler, press, heater etc. in the hostel, failing which personal appliance shall be seized and/or a penalty of Rs. 500/- will be imposed.
16. Room accommodation once allotted will not be changed.
17. No intoxicants (such as wine/beer/drugs/tobacco or its products) will be used by the hostel residents, failing which a fine up to Rs. 2000/- and/or cancellation of accommodation will be imposed.

18. No student will be allowed to leave hostel on working days without written permission of their Hod and Warden/Chief Warden.
19. If a student remains absent from the hostel for more than 24 hours without any permission of Warden/ Chief Warden a fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be imposed on him/her. Repetition of such an act may lead to cancellation of accommodation without any refund.
20. Though it will be the duty of hostel administration to provide the best stay arrangement/facilities, the students cannot claim anything as a matter of right and should be ready and willing to adjust themselves with the prevailing conditions and circumstances. Notwithstanding the above rules/guidelines, the decision of the Council of Wardens/Chief Warden shall prevail.
21. Aimless strolling and causing disturbance of any hostel resident outside the hostel premises after 9p.m. be treated as an undesirable activity which may lead to a penalty of Rs. 500/-
22. Any student, if found involved in locking the college main gate or doors in the college or if he obstructs College working in an unauthorized way, will be expelled from the hostel.
23. If a student is found involved in any type of undesirable activity, he will be punished accordingly. Marks of DECA will be deducted along with financial penalty.
24. (a) The hostel room will be allotted to an eligible student for a period of one year or till his summer main examinations, whichever is later.  
(b) A final B. Tech. pursuing hostel resident shall vacate the hostel within three days of the last date of his/her final Main Theory/Practical/Sessional/Viva-voce Examination.
25. Cooking food in hostel room is strictly prohibited.
26. Dining in the hostel mess is compulsory for all hostel residents, providing that the mess is functional.
27. The clothes worn by the students should not be vulgar or gaudy; they should rather be decent and dignified.
28. No fuel driven vehicle (two or four wheeler) is allowed in hostel premises. However, bicycle may be used.
29. High pitch sound producing instruments are not permitted in the hostel.
30. Use of PA (Personal Appliances) system without the permission of the Chief Warden is strictly prohibited, failing which a fine of Rs. 1000/- will be imposed on user and PA system will be seized.
31. Leave in case of illness of self or parents can be sanctioned by warden/ chief warden and submission of doctor's prescription is mandatory.
32. Leave in case of marriage of real brother or sister can be sanctioned after submission of invitation card. (Maximum twice in a semester)
33. It is mandatory to put signature in the attendance register/ give thumb impression in biometric system on a daily basis.

All or any of the above rules may be revised by college administration without any notice.
